**Video Editing Software:** Our B.Voc. (JMT) program utilizes industry-standard video editing software to equip students with hands-on experience in post-production techniques. Specifically, we employ Adobe Premiere Pro, Da Vinci Resolve, and Filmora to teach editing principles and best practices. Through these software tools, our students have successfully edited and published over 400 videos on our YouTube channel, STP News. This real-world application of editing skills not only enhances our student's technical proficiency but also fosters their creative expression and storytelling abilities.

**Page Design and Make Up Software:** Our B.Voc. (JMT) program incorporates QuarkXPress, a leading page design and layout software, to instruct students in the art of visual storytelling and page composition. With QuarkXPress, our students learn to create engaging and professional-grade layouts for various media platforms, including newspapers, magazines, and online publications. Through hands-on training and projects, our students develop a keen eye for design and typography, enabling them to effectively communicate messages and convey meaning through visually appealing page designs.

**Preview Room:** The preview room in our B.Voc. (JMT) studio is a multifunctional space that plays a vital role in our course.
