- 3. The house felt concerned over the spread of dengue and other illness during the month of September and October every year. The house suggested that municipality be requested to do fogging of pesticide every week. Moreover, college should organize a blood donation camp so that patients may get blood and plasma at ease during hospitalization.
- The house advised that more faculty members should go in for research degree.
 Moreover, they should write research papers, research books and got the research papers published in UGC approved research journals.
- 5. The matter regarding non release of enhanced grant by govt, for those ten grant-inaid posts which were confirmed during the last three years was discussed at length. The house felt that it was badly affecting the finances of the college. It was decided that matter regarding the release of this grant be taken up with O/o DPI Colleges Punjab, so that grant may be got released at the earliest.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT

On the decisions of the 27th IQAC meeting held on 11-09-22.

To implement the decisions of the above mentioned meeting of the IQAC, the following actions were taken: -

- 1. With the whole hearted support of Institution and motivation of staff college made a remarkable achievement in Zonal Youth and Folk Festival held at T.P.D. Malwa College Rampura Phul from 7-10-22 to 10-10-22. At Zonal Festival our students participated in 51 items. Our College remained overall winner securing 149 points. Our students won first position in 17 items, second position in 06 items and third in 12 items. Among 43 colleges in this competition, our college won Overall Championship Trophy, Overall Fine Arts Trophy, Overall Literary Items Trophy, Overall Music Items Trophy and Overall Folk Arts Trophy. In Inter Zonal Youth Festival held at Punjabi University Patiala from 10-11-22 to 13-11-22, our students won three Gold medals, three Silver medals and three Bronze medals.
- 2. College got the opportunity to host the Netball Championship at District level and State level under the banner "Khedan Watan Punjab Dian" from 15-10-2022 to 22-10-2022. Netball teams of both boys and girls under different age groups such as under 14, 17, 19, 21 and 31-40 years participated in the games. The Championship was inaugurated on 15-10-2022 by Hon'ble Sh. Gurmeet Singh Meet Hayer, Minister of Higher Education, Sports and Youth Affairs, Punjab. On 19-10-2022 Hon'ble Speaker of Punjab Legislative Assembly visited the college to encourage and bless the players.
- 3. The municipality and Public health departments on request of the college sent the machine to college campus for fogging of pesticide several times. Moreover, College through NSS wing organized a Blood Donation Camp dedicated to Shaheed Bhagat Singh on 30-09-2022. In this camp students and staff showing a sense of responsibility toward society donated 70 units of blood.
- Faculty members were asked to go in for research degree and publish research papers. In this
 session four teachers were pursuing Ph.D. and two teachers have received Ph.D. degree.
- The matter regarding the release of enhanced grant was taken up with O/o DPI Colleges Punjab. Grant was partially released by the govt. College received the grant for the year 2022-23 only. For the previous years grant was still awaited.
