The meeting commenced with welcome of all the members of the IQAC by the Coordinator.

The minutes of previous meeting held on 11th September 2022 were confirmed.

After a long discussion and deliberations on different issues placed by the members following decisions were taken: -

1. The house inquired regarding the preparation of AQAR for 2021-22, Dr. Rajesh Gupta informed the house that the work on AQAR was at very advanced stage. However, some university results were still awaited and data on student progression was not complete. Dr. Gupta ensured the house that Report would be submitted in the last week of this month as the last date of submission is 31st December 2022. The house showed its satisfaction over the issue.
2. The house desired to know the status of re-release of grant by DBT after the college was asked to deposit the unspent amount with DBT with the assurance that it would be released as per new PFMS system of disbursement and utilization





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
- of grant. Mrs. Kusam Sharma informed the house that unspent amount of first installment of grant has already been restored to the college few days ago.
3. The house suggested that keeping in mind the career prospects of the students efforts should be made to contact more IT companies/banks/finance companies etc. Moreover, some sort of training be provided to students to prepare them for tests, group discussion and interview.
 4. The house was of the view that most of our students were from rural area. Most of them were very shy and little exposer. Thus house recommended that for enhancing the exposure of the students especially students of vocational, professional and science streams be provided the opportunities of visiting various labs, companies, universities, reputed higher education institutions, business concerns etc.
 5. The house discussed at length the issue of non-release of Post Matric Scholarship Scheme funds by state government for the three sessions i.e. 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20. It amounted to more than Rs. One Crore. The house showed serious concern for the same and suggested that matter be once again taken up with O/o Director Social Welfare department, Punjab, so that amount may be got released at the earliest.

There being no other matter, meeting ended with vote of thanks by the Coordinator.

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
ACTION TAKEN REPORT

On the decisions of the 28th IQAC meeting held on 11-12-22.

To implement the decisions of the above mentioned meeting of the IQAC, the following actions were taken: -

1. The AQAR for 2021-22 was submitted to NAAC on 24-12-2022 and was accepted by NAAC.
2. The unspent amount of first installment was restored to college by DBT and activities under the scheme were going on full pace in all the five departments of Chemistry, Physics, Botany, Zoology and Mathematics.
3. Training and Placement Cell of the college in association with District Bureau of Employment Generation, Skill and Training Barnala organized Webinar on Recruitment Process for Enrollment of Eligible Youth as Agni veer Vayu. This webinar threw light on aspects of jobs in Air force. Moreover, Training and Placement Cell organized a program under Campus Placement Drive. World renowned company Goteso took the test and interview for the selection of students in their company. 60 students took part in selection process. Out of which company selected 6 students.
4. For the exposé of students various outdoor activities were conducted such as: Visit of students to medical labs, visit to Homi Bhabha Tata Memorial Hospital, Sangrur, Visit to C-DAC Mohali, Visit to Verka Milk Plant Sangrur, Visit to Central University Bathinda, Visit to Punjab University Chandigarh, Educational Visit to IISER Mohali, Educational Visit of Zoology students to MC Choudhary Zoological Park, Chhatbir, Educational Visit to Pushpa Gujral Science City and Kanjli Wetland in Kapurthala, Visit to Thapar Institute of Engineering and Technology, Visit to SS Bir Botanical garden, Pbi.Uni. Patiala.
5. Matter for release of PMS Scheme funds for three years i.e. 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 was taken up many times with O/o Director, Social Welfare department, Punjab. However, no funds were received till date.
