

Analysis of Feedback from students

Students of SD college were asked to give their feedback regarding teachers, whether they regularly and punctually take lectures, complete their syllabus, have knowledge of the subject, their skill and confidence, environment in the class, effective use of ICT tools, Study material provided by the teachers, effective mentoring and career guidance to students and were asked to give their suggestions for the improvement in the teaching or college in general. Students were also asked their awareness about the credits earned by doing online course and about the skill development course.

Most of the students are satisfied that the teachers take the lectures regularly and punctually and complete the syllabus well in time. Majority of them are also satisfied that the teachers had the knowledge of their subjects, they are quite confident and provide environment to have discussions with the students. Wherever possible, teachers complement theory classes with lab experiments. The teachers also provide effective mentoring and guidance to the students. Large number of students had an idea that they can earn credits by doing online courses. They were also aware about skill development courses. However some of the students gave certain suggestions:

1. Fee should be less for the economically weaker students
2. Want more time for the extracurricular activities
3. Want recreational & educational tours.
4. Want cleanliness of classrooms
5. Want more job fairs.
6. Want regular class tests and extra classes to be taken by the teachers.
7. Want more focus on practical work.
8. Want addition of more books in the library.
9. Want common place for boys and girls in the free time
10. Want improvement in the behaviour of administrative staff.
11. Want that syllabus should be modified and reduced in some subjects
12. Want more use of ICT tools.
13. Want better drinking water arrangements.
14. Want more girl's washroom.

Analysis of Feedback from teachers

Teachers were asked to give feedback about the relevance of syllabus, use of ICT tools, preparedness of teaching staff to use them, availability of books in the library, about college leadership, support from administrative staff, job satisfaction, personal and professional growth, academic freedom, workload, college environment, conferences and workshops organized in the college, hygiene and cleanliness, fire security management etc.

From the feedback, it can be concluded that majority of teachers are satisfied in context to the relevance of syllabus, library facility as well as ICT facility available in the college. Majority of teachers were also satisfied with the college leadership, behaviour of administrative staff, personal and professional growth, academic freedom etc. However, many teachers wanted improvement in following points:

1. Conferences, workshops to be organized in college.
2. Cleanliness of rooms.
3. Workload related to other activities is more.

Most of the teachers were also satisfied with the support provided by the college for extracurricular activities, NCC, NSS, youth festivals etc.

Majority of the teachers think that NEP 2020 will be beneficial for students due to emphasis on vocational courses and multi disciplinary approach.


