Subject: Regarding the discrepancy in question paper of "Medical Parasitology" of B Voc (MLMDT) – Part II, Sem IV

Sir,

This is to bring to your kind notice that the question paper of "Medical Parasitology" of B Voc MLMDT – II, Sem IV held on 3^{rd} June 2023 had many questions that are out of syllabus. Details of the same are as follows:

Section A:

Q3. 'Describe Immunological Techniques used to diagnose Protozoan and detail of Fluorescent based and Enzyme based methods with examples' is not in the syllabus. (15 marks)

Q4. 'Describe the life cycle, disease, transmission and diagnosis of P. Falciparum' is out of syllabus. In the syllabus only the life cycle of <u>P.vivax</u> is mentioned. (15 marks)

Section B:

Q5. Examiner has asked to give the 'major characteristic features of Helminths and differentiating feature of Nematodes, Cestodes and Trematodes' where as in syllabus only the lab diagnosis of Cestodes and Trematodes (Unit IV) is mentioned. (15 marks)

Q7. Examiner has asked to write on account of "Hydatid worm and disease caused by it. Describe its life cycle.". Hydatid worms is not mentioned in the syllabus at all. (15 marks)

Q8. Examiner has asked symptoms and causes of Schistosomiasis where as in the syllabus only lab diagnosis is mentioned (Unit IV) (15 marks)

(i) Life cycle and important morphological features are asked for 1.5 marks only which is a long answer question

(viii) PCR principle& comparison with LAMP

(ix) LAMP is diagnostic tool

(x) RFLP significance

Above Q9 (viii), (ix) and (x) are completely out of syllabus.

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
